

**Site Guidelines
for
Creek Week Cleanup Sites**

Roseville Sites

Central Roseville

Site 1: Dry Creek - Royer Park to Saugstad Park

- Location: Site 1 extends along the south banks of Dry Creek from Royer Park to Saugstad Park.
- Parking: Park in the Saugstad Park parking lot located off Douglas Boulevard at Park Drive.
- Participants: 20-35
- Garbage Drop
- Location: A dumpster is located in Saugstad Park next to the bike trail.
- Cautions: Stay off steep slopes behind zoo
- Private Property: Stay off private property on the west side of Dry Creek through Saugstad Park
- NOTES: Please note objects that were too large for removal (describe the location as best you can) and turn in to committee. Also, include any “site tips” for next years event.

Site 2: Dry Creek Open Space from Folsom Road to Harding Boulevard

- Location: Meet at Lincoln Estates Park located at 331 James Drive. From Folsom Road turn onto Evelyn, and follow the road to James Drive. Site No. 2 extends along the southern bank of Dry Creek from Lincoln Estates Park to Harding Boulevard. Avoid the private property at the east end of Site No. 2, parallel to the terminus of James Drive.
- Parking: Park on James Drive next to the park.
- Participants: 10-20
- Garbage Drop
- Location: Place garbage bags next to garbage cans near play area in Lincoln Estates Park.
- Cautions: Watch for poison oak, and steep areas of bank.
- NOTES: Please note objects that were too large for removal (describe the location as best you can) and turn in to committee. Also, include any “site tips” for next years event.

Site 3: Dry Creek from Sutter Avenue to Adelante High School and between Harding Boulevard and East Street

Location: Meet at Doyle Street and Atlantic
Parking: Park in the Adelante High School parking lot.
Participants: 20-30
Garbage
Drop
Location: Place garbage bags next to the sidewalk at the bridge on Folsom Street.
Cautions: Avoid private property east of East Street and west of the Roseville Joint Union High School District property.
NOTES: Please note objects that were too large for removal (describe the location as best you can) and turn in to committee. Also, include any “site tips” for next years event.

Site 4: Linda Creek - Oakridge Drive to Rocky Ridge Drive

Location: Site 4 extends along the banks of Linda Creek from Oakridge Drive upstream to Rocky Ridge Drive. Enter the open space via the bike path at the terminus of Woodlake Lane. Follow the bike path to the footbridge. Suggest breaking up the group at that point - send half upstream to Rocky Ridge Drive and half down stream to Oakridge Drive.
Parking: Park on Woodlake Lane which dead ends into the Linda Creek open space and bike trail: head north on Oakridge off Cirby Way, right on Rampart Drive, left on Chareleston Circle, left on Woodlake Lane. Park at the terminus of Woodlake Lane.

Tips: Downstream to Oakridge Drive - follow bike path and watch for dirt trails that lead to the creek. These provide excellent creek access from the main path and lead to areas where people congregate and garbage accumulates. Stay on the bike path side of the creek; slope becomes too steep on the opposite side.

Tips: Upstream to Rocky Ridge Drive - In this area the floodplain is broad and includes expansive open space area. spread out and attempt to cover the entire floodplain. Continue upstream towards Rocky Ridge as far as conditions permit (i.e., level topography/safe conditions).

Participants: 30-50
Garbage
Drop
Location: Place garbage bags in a pile at the terminus of Woodlake Lane.
NOTES: Please note objects that were too large for removal (describe the location as best you can) and turn in to committee. Also, include any “site tips” for next year’s event.

Site 5: Cirby Creek from Eastwood Park - Sunrise Avenue

Location: Meet at Eastwood Park located at 1100 Madden Lane. Turn onto Coral Drive or Salmon Drive from Cirby Way, and follow the road to the park. Site 5 extends along the southern banks of Cirby Creek from Eastwood Park to Sunrise Boulevard.

Parking: Park on the street on Madden Lane or Coral Drive, across from the Park.

Participants: 10-20

Garbage

Drop

Location: Place garbage bags next to the garbage cans at the ball field in Eastwood Park.

Cautions: Watch your footing where the footpath becomes narrow, and close to the edge of a steep bank.

NOTES: Please note objects that were too large for removal (describe the location as best you can) and turn in to committee. Also, include any "site tips" for next years event.

East Roseville

Site 6: Miner's Ravine - Sculpture Park along bike trail

Location: Site 6 extends along the banks of Dry Creek from Sculpture Park upstream to the first bike trail bridge near the U.A. Theater, and then along the bike trail.

Parking: Park in the UA Theater parking lot: Turn into the parking lot off North Sunrise Avenue. Park near the trailhead at the bottom of the hill.

Participants: 30-100

Garbage

Drop

Location: Place garbage bags in a pile near the parking lot.

NOTES: Please note objects that were too large for removal (describe the location as best you can) and turn in to committee. Also, include any "site tips" for next years event.

Site 7: Maidu Park - Strap Ravine Open Space in the Eastern Half of Maidu Park

Location: Site 7 includes Strap Ravine through Maidu Park and the associated open space.

Parking: In Maidu Park. From the parking lot, walk to the eastern side of the park (past the ballfields) to the Strap Ravine Open Space area.

Participants: 10-20

Garbage

Drop

Location: Place garbage bags in a pile near the ball fields snack bar.

NOTES: Please note objects that were too large for removal (describe the location as best you can) and turn in to committee. Also, include any “site tips” for next years event.

Site 8: Cirby Creek between Professional Drive and Douglas Blvd.

Site Leader: Marty Vavoudis

Location: Site 8 is on Cirby creek and includes the area east of Professional Drive and south of Douglas Boulevard.

Parking: Park in the southeast corner of parking lot at 2440 Professional Drive. To get to this site turn south off Douglas onto Professional Drive.

Participants: 20-30

Garbage

Drop

Location: Place garbage bags next to the dumpster in the southeast corner of the parking lot.

Cautions: Parts of this site can be severely overgrown with vegetation, avoid these areas.

NOTES: Please note objects that were too large for removal (describe the location as best you can) and turn in to committee. Also, include any “site tips” for next years event.

Site 9: Antelope Creek –Confluence at Dry Creek to Roseville Parkway Bridge. Site Leader: Tony Morris

Location: Site 9 extends along the banks of Antelope Creek from its confluence at Dry Creek upstream to the Highway 65 Bridge.

Parking: From Roseville Parkway turn on Creekside Ridge Court and turn right on Antelope Creek Drive. Drive past the bridge and park along the road or off the pavement. An alternative is to park in back lot of Agilent Technologies and walk down to the creek.

Participants: 30-50

Garbage

Drop

Location: Place garbage bags in a pile near the parking areas but not on the roadway.

NOTES: Please note objects that were too large for removal (describe the location as best you can) and turn in to committee. Also, include any “site tips” for next year’s event.

West Roseville

Site 10: South Branch Pleasant Grove Creek from Rube Nelson Park to Foothills Boulevard

Site Leader: _____

Location: Meet at Rube Nelson Park located on South Bluff Drive. From Foothills Boulevard turn onto South Bluff Drive and follow the road to the park. Access to the creek begins at the bike trailhead directly across the street from the park. Site No. 10 extends along the southern banks of South Branch Pleasant Grove Creek from Rube Nelson Park to Foothills Boulevard. Avoid the private property on the opposite banks (north) of the Creek.

Parking: Park on South Bluff Drive next to the park.

Participants: 10-20

Garbage

Drop

Location: Place garbage bags next to the trail at the entrance to the bike path.

Cautions: Watch your footing in the tall grasses.

Avoid the private property on the opposite banks (north) of the creek.

NOTES: Please note objects that were too large for removal (describe the location as best you can) and turn in to committee. Also, include any “site tips” for next years event.

Site 11: NWRSP Wetland Preserve - Pleasant Grove Creek Tributary from Woodcreek Oaks Boulevard to east of Caragh Street

Location: Site 11 extends along a tributary to Pleasant Grove Creek between Woodcreek Oaks Boulevard and east of Caragh Street. The site supports vernal pools and wetlands created as mitigation for buildout of the Woodcreek Oaks Neighborhood.

Parking: Meet at the Roseville Aquatics Complex parking lot located at 3051 Woodcreek Oaks Boulevard, just north of Woodcreek High School.

Participants: 10-20

Garbage

Drop

Location: Place garbage bags near where the bike path intersects with Caragh Street.

NOTES: Please note objects that were too large for removal (describe the location as best you can) and turn in to committee. Also, include any “site tips” for next years event.

Site 12: Mahany Park - Kaseberg Creek Open Space

Location: Meet at the Roseville Aquatics Complex parking lot located at 3051 Woodcreek Oaks Boulevard, just north of Woodcreek High School. Site 12 includes the Kaseberg Creek open space area in Mahany Park. The site is bounded by Mahany Park on the north, Woodcreek High School on the south, Woodcreek Oaks Boulevard on the east, and the pump station at the end of the bike trail/gravel road on the west.

Parking: Park in the Roseville Aquatics Complex parking lot.

Participants: 30-40

Garbage

Drop

Location: Place garbage bags in a pile near the Group Picnic area.

NOTES: Please note objects that were too large for removal (describe the location as best you can) and turn in to committee. Also, include any “site tips” for next years event.

Site 13: McNally Drive - Kaseberg Creek Open Space

Location: Meet at the Roseville Aquatics Complex parking lot located at 3051 Woodcreek Oaks Boulevard, just north of Woodcreek High School. Site 13 includes the Kaseberg Creek open space area located north of McNally Drive and east of Woodcreek Oaks Boulevard.

Parking: Park in the Roseville Aquatics Complex parking lot.

Participants: 30-40

Garbage

Drop

Location: Place garbage bags in a pile near the pump station.

NOTES: Please note objects that were too large for removal (describe the location as best you can) and turn in to committee. Also, include any “site tips” for next years event.
